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## Assessment for end of Term

How time flies, we are coming to the end of the term in another few weeks! Before the closure of the term, assessment tasks will be given to students.

The primary purpose of assessment is to promote learning. Assessment gives evidence of how students are progressing according to defined standards throughout a period of learning, as well as achievement at the end of the learning period. Willis and Cowie, refer to assessment as a 'generative dance' wherein assessment is:

"re-imagined as a dynamic space in which teachers learn about their students as they learn with their students, and where all students can be empowered to find success and in turn develop learner agency" Quality assessment includes both the cognitive and affective domains. It is informed, purposeful, authentic, valid and reliable. (ACT, Teachers Guide to Assessment)

We are mindful that our students have just had a term of learning in Ming-De, especially the Preps and Year 1. Hence the assessments conducted will mainly be formative, taking account of their daily work and learning.

Parents are expected to receive their child/ren's report on the 30th of September (Monday).



## **Student Portfolio**

A student portfolio has been developed for each child. It contains work samples collected as part of the overall assessment and reporting process, and includes samples of work, and examples of work in progress. If any parent wished to see their child's assessment portfolio, a meeting time can be arranged once we return to school in term 4.

Once you receive the report, take time as a family to celebrate your child's achievements, talk about what can be improved on. But remember, your child has had the challenges of establishing themselves at a new school.

#### Things to look for in the child's portfolio:

- Evidence of development improvement and progress
- Best work practices and best efforts
- Presentation elements
- . Content of their work
- Evidence of creative thinking in their work
- Signs of "having a go" and risk-taking with their learning



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## **Parent Teacher Phone Interview**

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The aim of the Parent Teacher Interview is to clarify any issues related to the assessment report, to discuss the child's progress towards achievement of this term's Learning goals, to share the student's Learning goal for next term and to discuss one of the student's assessment tasks in their Student Portfolio.

For this term, due to the pandemic, teachers will be conducting a phone interview with the parents to reduce the number of people attending the school.

- ❖ For Prep and Year 1, Parent Teacher Phone Interviews will take place on 14/9 – 15/9, between 3.00pm – 4.30pm.
- ❖ For Year 3, it will be held on the 14/09, between 3.00 – 4.30pm.

Interviews are scheduled for 15 minutes. If a parent needs to discuss a significant issue about their child, an alternative time will need to be arranged.
